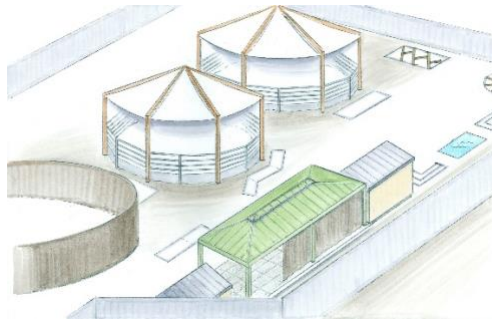

1. Wellness Outpost



This area provides a private space for military and mental health clients to participate in support groups, counseling, and horse-based healing on a trail challenge course.

2. Mental Health and Speech Therapy Offices

The program office makeover will give speech and mental health staff offices as well as treatment space to boost the benefits of horse therapy.

3. Happy Trails – A Safe Entrance to and from Local Trails



The equestrian trail is safer to enter and exit with this new route, and the high and low keypad codes are required to open the gate, enhancing security. Rerouting the trail entrance enabled much-needed storage space.

4. Staff Oasis



We are creating an outdoor oasis for staff to rest, relax and recharge with shaded tables, lockers, and a training space.

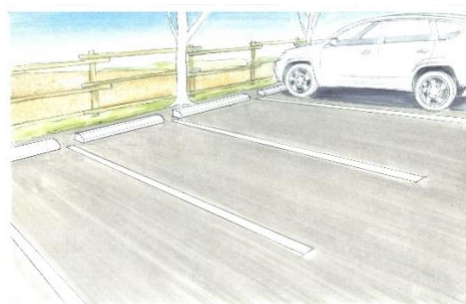
6. Barn Retreat



This is a place for our exceptional barn and outdoor teams to have an area to rest and renew during the workday. It features lockers, a cooled environment, tables and chairs as well as a refrigerator to store lunches and keep beverages cool.

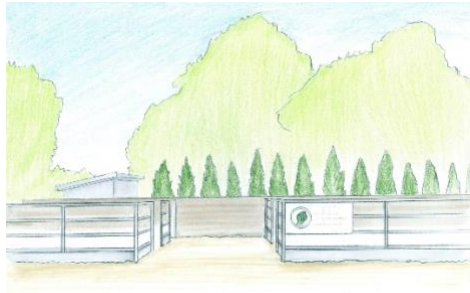
7. The South Lot – Client and Volunteer Parking



In our current south parking area, we are adding additional parking spaces, wheel stops, striping and improved water management and efficiency so that our clients and volunteers have safe and mobility-friendly surfaces on which to access our front gate.

8. Sunshine Stalls



The Shea Center's north property area offers a sunny spot for our horses to socialize and relax. The four outdoor, open stalls allow them to interact with other horses, enjoy the sunshine, have downtime and stay healthy.

9. Transforming the Gateway to Shea



Much-needed improvements to our driveway entrance will improve both security and safety along our shared driveway. The improvements will also enhance the overall functionality, appearance and beauty of the entire area.

10. Round Pens



We will replace both training round pens which allow for greater interactions between horse and handler. One pen will have a cover, so our clients and horses can learn, train and exercise in all weather. The other will be uncovered to enjoy the benefits of the sun for both humans and horses.

\$175,000 covered round pen**

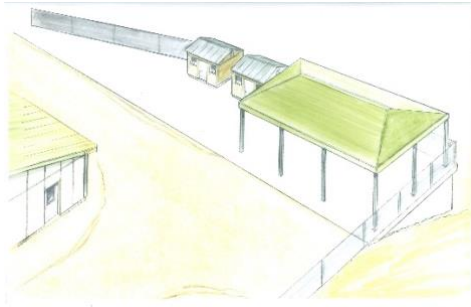
11. Covered Euro Walker



The Euro Walker is a much-needed aspect of how we care for our horses. This equipment enables multiple horses to be exercised at once at the walk or trot to maintain overall equine health. The new Euro Walker will be covered allowing for use in all weather conditions and will feature a durable mat system for horse comfort and ease of maintenance.

12. The Maintenance Lot – Parking for Truck, Tractor, Cart and Storage Sheds



By expanding the usable land at the back of the barn, we will add about 1500 square feet of much-needed space for the tractors and storage sheds. It allows us to keep heavy equipment safely away from clients and much-needed storage for larger tools and maintenance supplies.

Every working ranch needs repairs. This area will organize all the tools and specialty equipment needed for the maintenance team. The Shop will also feature work benches and space for making repairs. The Shop features storage for two golf carts used to service the facility and tour mobility-impaired guests.
